# Bricking a 2 x 4 Classic Evaporator

## **Tools & Material Required**

- Brick Saw
- Tape Measure
- Large Brick
- Small Brick
- 2 Gallon Cement Mix

Protect the outside of Evaporator



Brick laying the bottom of the evaporator

Motor over the edges to seal them





Do the brick work in the first row of the rear wall

A cut in the angle on the corner of the bricks to the outside is necessary







Make the first rank of brick on the other sides



Brick the sides and rear wall

Cross the bricks which is located in the rear corners, in a way which does not have a seal.









The last row is done with the small bricks

1 ¼ x4 ½ x 9 cut off in such a way as to what

does not exceed the height of the

evaporator



Leave to dry the cement during a minimum of 48 hours and then make a pre-cooking soft fire during 3 hours before use
